

Inmate Correspondence

All incoming non-privileged mail will be on plain white paper or legal pad (White) only and mailed in a plain white or manila envelope. The letters must be written in blue or black ink.

Letters should be addressed as follows:

- a) Show Senders Full name and address on the envelope.
- b) Show inmates full name (the name by which they were booked into jail)
- c) Address the letter to c/o:
